

Comment period remains open

Cape Vincent – Area residents are reminded that the comment period for the Draft Environmental Issue Statement (DEIS) for the proposed St. Lawrence Wind Farm project remains open until June 15.

A supplemental document of the DEIS is now available to the public: the Historic Architectural Resource Investigation (1-mile ring area of potential effects). This Historic Architectural Resource Investigation catalogs properties 50 years or older within view of the wind turbines and within a one-mile ring of them. The inventories include cemeteries, properties that are listed in the National Register of Historic Places (NHRP), and properties recommended as potentially eligible for the NHRP. The report follows guidelines established by the New York State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) Guidelines for Wind Development Cultural Resources Survey Work.

Printed copies of the Historic Architectural Resource Investigation are now available with each public copy of the DEIS in the following locations: the Cape Vincent Town Clerk's office, the Cape Vincent Village office, the Cape Vincent Library, the St. Lawrence Wind Farm office, the Lyme Town Clerk's office, and the Lyme Free Library.
